

# Emergency Preparedness Exercise

Important information about a test in two Boston neighborhoods  
Sunday, September 23, 2007

This is only a test. There is no emergency.

## WHAT:

On Sunday, September 23, 2007 local, state, and federal officials are conducting a drill to test the delivery of emergency medications.

## WHERE:

Postal carriers will deliver small, empty, cardboard boxes to approximately 23,000 households in two Boston neighborhoods: the South End (02118) and West Roxbury (02132). A Boston Police officer will escort each postal carrier as part of the test.

## WHY:

If a bioterrorist attack were to happen in Boston, large numbers of people are likely to need emergency medications quickly. Using local postal carriers may be one way to get these emergency medications to people. For this test, the empty box is meant to represent emergency medications that would prevent people from becoming sick from a bioterrorist attack.

In an actual emergency, you should tune in to local radio or television for news from local public officials on how to protect yourself or get help.
